Maintenance Person

Department: Maintenance

Supervisor: Manager

Term: Early May to Late September

Position Description:

The Maintenance Person performs daily chores such as cleaning vehicles, maintaining buildings, grounds, systems and appliances, as well as specific light construction projects.

Major Functions:

The Maintenance person works to repair and maintain all facilities, systems, vehicles and grounds to make sure that our facilities looks great and can function smoothly. Work in maintenance can be varied but also involves many routines such as washing and fueling vehicles, hauling and burning trash, yard work, mopping the front porches and painting. Maintenance must be responsive to other departments requests for repairs, especially in the Guest areas

Required Skills and Abilities:

Previous maintenance experience and familiarity with hand and power tools are desired, but may also be taught on the job. A commitment to safety is mandatory. A working knowledge of any or some of the following is desired: building construction, small engine/auto repair, power generation, electrical and plumbing systems, painting, woodworking, bicycle maintenance/repair, and large equipment operation. The ability to work and communicate in a team environment and the ability to be selfmotivated when working independently are essential in this position.

Other Requirements:

Must be at least 18 years old. Must possess a current driver's license and have a clean driving record for the past three years

Working Conditions & Physical Demands:

Maintenance tasks frequently require working outdoors, regardless of rain, snow, mosquitoes, heat or cold. Personal protective equipment is provided to mitigate exposure to hazardous materials, loud noise, power tools and other hazards associated with maintenance tasks. Physical demands can include being on one's feet for long periods, walking up steep, hilly terrain, and lifting/carrying heavy loads.

Compensation:

Salary for this position is \$1350 per month, based on an eight hour work day, five days per week. There is no charge for room and board. Lodge Guest gratuities are pooled and divided equally among all Staff, amounting to about \$300 to \$500 per month. A performance bonus is provided to those completing their agreed term of hire.
