

Job Title:	Facilities Maintenance

Work Dates:	Early May to Late September

Position Description:

The Facilities Maintenance position performs a variety of tasks to make sure that our facilities look great and function smoothly.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with opening the Lodge in the spring and closing the Lodge in the fall
- Maintain Lodge systems include plumbing, electrical, power generation, and water system
- Repair small appliances including washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, coffee machine, ice makers, lawn mowers etc.
- Other duties as needed: painting, repairing drywall, light carpentry, and general building maintenance, etc

Key Requirements:

- Previous maintenance experience is required
- Self motivated and good time management skills
- Willingness to learn and desire to help out where needed
- Physical fit
- Must be 21 years or older and have a current driver's license with a clean driving record for the last three years

Working Conditions & Physical Demands:

Maintenance tasks frequently require working outdoors, regardless of rain, snow, mosquitoes, heat or cold. Physical demands can include being on one's feet for long periods, walking up steep, hilly terrain, and lifting/carrying heavy loads.

Work Schedule:

This position works 8 hours per day, five days per week.

Compensation and Benefits:

- \$15 to \$20 per hour DOE
- Free housing and three meals each day
- Transportation between Anchorage and Kennicott Glacier Lodge at the beginning and end of work dates
- Split of Lodge Guest gratuities (Tips = \$600 to \$1000 per month in 2022)
- Performance bonus of \$750 for completing agreed work dates
